# Call for Applications

The BMW Foundation Herbert Quandt is opening a call for applications as part of a study to be published in 2020. The topic is:

**Impact and Challenges of Tech for Good: An Overview on Scalable Innovative Solutions and Implications on Global Societal, Environmental, and Economic Challenges.**

The study will include up to 15 articles with a focus on one or more of the following aspects of sustainable development: economic growth, innovation and infrastructure, and/or sustainable cities and communities.

Impact tech entrepreneurs who are experts in the field of technological innovation are invited to submit a proposal for an article until March 15th, 2020 on the impact and challenges of a relevant technology sector in his /or her area of expertise.

The article should also reflect on the role of responsible leadership to achieve sustainability in the specific field technology. The results of the selection process will be communicated on April 30th.

If selected, each expert will be asked to submit an article (8-10 pages) on the proposed topic. A financial compensation of up to a maximum of 15.000 EUR exclusive value added tax can be paid depending on the scope of each article.
